PREPARE FOR SUCCESS

Can you meet the requirements?

- Be at least 18 years old
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Have a CDL permit
- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Be nicotine and drug free
- Pass pre-employment testing
- Have basic mechanical aptitude and math/calculation skills
- Previous work experience in a power plant, or in manufacturing, industrial, commercial, warehousing, construction or other safety-related setting preferred but not required

Pre-Employment Testing

- Plant Operator Selection System (POSS) and Plant Maintenance Positions Selection System (MASS) tests - Measures the reasoning abilities found to be important for successful job performance of plant operators and maintenance technicians
